## How to Submit the Project -

Student has to work on the project and record a 3 minute video explaining the project and submit the same.

## Project Submission Guidelines -

- 1. Last date of submission of video of project: 15<sup>th</sup> February 2022
- 2. Video should include: the Project Title, Material used, entire Process of experiment and Final Project, Working, Observation, Results, Inference drawn from that experiment. (It is perfectly fine if 1 or 2 points are missed out from the list)
- 3. The video duration should not be more than 3 minutes.

## Video Making Guidelines-

- 1. Final project is to be submitted in the form of a video presentation.
- 2. Please use good quality camera/mobile camera for recording.
- 3. Please make sure that the audio is clearly recorded and the video clearly shows the aspects which the project is trying to highlight.
- 4. Need to capture proper understandable view while recording.
- 5. Participant needs to record, with audio and video, all the process of project as mentioned above along with the name and class of the student, names and photos of participants if made in group.
- 6. Video recording should not be more than 3 minutes.
- > Students need to submit their project to their respective Science teacher by 15<sup>th</sup> February 2022.
