School Re-Opening

Dear Parents,

Greetings of the day!

Thanks to technology for keeping the education going for our kids during the tough times. It’s now time for the School campuses to re-open, after a prolonged period of time.

As per the Government directives, C M International School has planned to reopen physical classes for Grade I – VIII shifting from virtual to physical learning will be back on track soon. Back-to-school has arrived! We hope that students are excited and all set for back to normal.

We assure our parents that standard operation procedures will be followed for re-opening of the school and parents are requested to encourage and guide their wards for physical classes in the school.

We wish to share with you our preparedness and expectation from parents as well as students to make this comeback a success.

School Preparedness

- A Task Force/Committee is formed in the school for management and monitoring the re-opening procedures in the school.
- Safety of students and employees is going to be our top most priority.
- The whole school is thoroughly sanitized using recommended disinfectants, including classrooms, stairs, corridors, restrooms, staffroom and common rooms. Sanitization of the entire campus is going to be a regular practice and will be done on daily basis.
- Hand sanitizers are placed at the appropriate places.
- Temperature screening and oximeter checking is compulsory at the entry.
- Our school staff is vaccinated.
- Our school has made a provision for a separate Isolation Unit for handling emergency situations.
- Provision for medical care along with updated First-Aid Kit has been made available in the isolation unit.
- Covid-19 awareness boards are displayed in the school premises for spreading awareness amongst the students.

- Training for staff is conducted on a regular basis with the following topics being covered Hygiene, Cough Etiquettes, Social Distancing, Covid-19 appropriate behaviour, etc.

School Routine to be followed during Physical classes

- Students should sanitize their hands before entering school campus and their respective classroom.
- Timetable will be shared.
- No assemblies will be conducted.
- Students will be given permanent seats. One student per bench and strict instructions will be given to avoid changing places.
- Sanitizers and closed dustbins are kept inside the classroom.
- Classrooms are sanitized every day after school.

Instructions to be followed by Students and Parents

- Parents should sensitize and teach their ward to follow hygiene practices.
- Parents should clean and sanitize their ward's uniform and belongings daily at high temperatures, using bleach based detergent powder/liquid/soap, without shaking the clothes.
- Parents should not send their ward to school if any member of the family, or anybody with whom the ward has come in close contact, is suspected to have Covid-19 infection.
- Parents should regularly monitor the health of their wards.
- Students should always wear a mask in the school campus (carry extra masks, napkins and sanitizer bottles).
- Students should maintain physical distance from other students and teachers.
- Students should wash hands frequently or use hand sanitizer regularly.
- Students should carry their own personal water bottles/tiffins to the school.

We will be following all the guidelines and procedures as per the directives received from the government.


Let's pray to Almighty to give us strength and power to overcome the difficulties and to make this re-opening of the school a success.
