All India Colouring, Handwriting, Collage Making, Drawing, Painting and Essay Writing Competition 2023-24

Dear Parents,

We are happy to inform you that 'National Education and Human Resource Development Organization', a prestigious National Institute has organized an annual " Colouring, Handwriting, Collage Making, Drawing & Painting and Essay Writing Competition 2023-24" for students studying between Class (**Junior KG & Senior KG**) to Class 10th.

Details of the competition are mentioned below as per category.

Colouring Competition

This competition will be conducted group-wise. Students will be given a picture, they need to colour it as per the instructions.

Group	Class
1	Junior KG to II
2	III & IV
3	V to VII
4	VIII to X

Any medium (watercolours, pastel crayons, sketch pens, coloured ink, coloured pencils, poster colours) can be used, singly or in combination for colouring the picture.

Handwriting Competition

In this competition, the students studying between Class II to Class X can participate. A participant is required to write down any paragraph from any textbook in English or Hindi. Class 2nd to Class 10th students can use single-line paper which will be provided by the school.

Picture Collage Competition

In this competition, the students studying between Class Junior KG to Class X can participate. A participant should bring a minimum of 2 and a maximum of 5 pictures of Mahatma Gandhi from home (either from newspapers, magazines or printouts) and students will make collages of these pictures on the provided A4 size sheet.

Drawing & Painting Competition

In this competition, the students studying between Classes I to X can participate. Following are the subjects according to their class. A 4-size sheet will be provided by the school.

- 1) From Class I to III: Subject – Any Fruit
- 2) From Class IV to X: Subject – My Clean India

Essay Writing Competition

Write an essay on any one topic in Hindi or English Language. Word limit:- Class I and II 10 to 15 lines, Class III and IV- 300 words, Class V to X - 500 words.

Topic- “ONE STEP TOWARDS CLEANLINESS ” “ एक कदम 4Dशता की ओर ”

- 1) A participant is required to write his/her full Name, Class, Division and school Name on the provided sheet.
- 2) Every participating student will receive a Certificate of Participation.
- 3) Every participant will get a complimentary gift.
- 4) The best students in each category will receive Medals or Trophy awards

Important Notes:-

- All these activities will be conducted in the school.
- Students are to bring the material required from home on the day of the competition
- A schedule of different activities will be given after we receive all the entries.
- If you want to enrol your ward on any of their activities, kindly submit the name of your ward to the class teacher along with the entry fee.
- Entry fees are to be sent in cash in a sealed envelope. Name, Class, Section and title of the activities, and amount (inside envelope) should be legibly written on the outer side of the envelope.
- Kindly note – Entry Fee per activity is Rs. 90 /-
- Children can participate in more than one activity. Accordingly, the fee varies.
- The competition will be held after the Term-1 Examinations are over.
